



Emergency Preparedness

Calling 911

- State your name, location, telephone number
 - Describe your emergency
 - Who is involved?
 - If in a car, give its description, location or direction
 - Follow instructions of the 911 dispatcher
 - In a fire, smoke or carbon monoxide emergency, exit building immediately
 - Ensure Dispatch has your gate code
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Assist Our Arrival

- Turn house and front lights on
 - If you're hard to find, send someone to flag us in
 - Make sure we have clear access to you
 - Secure pets and small children
 - Give us current list of medications, allergies and medical history
 - Give us a family contact: name and phone
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Be Ready

- House Number at street and on house
 - Trim driveway shrubbery to allow passage of emergency vehicles (14' wide x 12' high)
 - Consider installing ramps if you rely on a wheelchair or are incapacitated
 - Have current DNR or MOLST form available if applicable
